- 14. **A**. A fee schedule for cost recovery in conjunction with OCFA Ordinance No 1 was discussed. Proposed rates were as follows:

Residential Multi-Family Building \$ 2,500 or Actual cost whichever is less
Commercial Building \$ 2,500 or Actual cost whichever is less
Industrial/Manufacturing \$ 2,500 or Actual cost whichever is greater

Aircraft/Fire Actual Cost
Commercial Truck Actual Cost
Hazardous Material Incident Actual Cost

Vegetation Fire less than 10 acres \$500

Vegetation Fire more than 10 acres Actual Cost

Utility Lines/Pipeline 1st hour \$0

2<sup>nd</sup> hour \$ 150 3<sup>rd</sup> hour \$ 500

 Actual costs will be calculated on employees' hours, materials used, and the FEMA equipment rate schedule.

## Motion by Bonny to accept the rate schedule as presented. Mary seconded the motion. AIF. MC.

- **B.** A recommendation on behalf of the firefighters was made to reduce the amount of pay to probationary firefighters who have yet to complete the Firefighter 1 and 2 courses. Since these individuals cannot fully participate on fire scenes it was felt that a decreased wage would be allowable. The amount of \$13 per hour was recommended to the board. **Motion by Mary to pay Probationary Firefighters \$13 per hour. Norm seconded the motion. AIF. MC.**
